Language Arts:

Reading – continue to take DIBELS tests throughout the week. We will also be working on our “Me Books” and reading for fun.

Spelling – List 145 test will be on Friday. The paragraph is just as important as the list of words, please keep that in mind when studying with your child.

VoWac – Lessons 141-142 will be learned. These lessons will include: open and closed syllables (short and long vowel sounds), and syllable division.

English – We will be having fun with telling and asking question this week.

Handwriting – no lessons this week.

Religion:

We will begin our unit on the Circle of Grace . We will discuss good feelings, touches and a safety plan. I will hand out Mass parts for the following week. Our class will be divided into two sections for these parts with only half of the students receiving a part each time we prepare the school mass. I will choose 12 students to have a speaking part, carry the gifts, or be a greeter for the first mass.

Science/Health:

Begin Chapter 1 – Animals Change. Your child will be given a Study Guide to practice nightly (vocabulary words). The Study Guide **NEEDS** to be in your child’s folder at ALL times so it can be utilized for both home and school studying.

Social Studies:

We will begin Unit 1 – We Belong to Many Groups. There will also be a Study Guide given out to practice the vocabulary words nightly. This is to be kept in your child’s folder at **ALL** times. You can take it out to practice at home and we will also use it in class.

Math:

Our lessons this week will be: counting and comparing, skip counting, patterns in numbers and charts. We will continue to use the Promethean Boards for math activities.
