Language Arts:

Reading - We will continue with the story David's New Friends this week since we have a short week. We will work on these skills: Characters, settings, fluency, decoding, and comprehension. On Friday we will be reading the Scholastic News weekly magazine.

Spelling - List 150 Test will be on Friday. This list contains mainly of words with a Long A sound. The list will come home on Friday so please start practicing over the weekend.

VoWac - Lessons 145-147 will be studied. We will learn about: -ch and -tch. We will review how to separate words into words parts according to vowel/consonant position within a word, the Sam Likes Fried Zebra rule and Fat Cat/Skinny Kitty rule. The first TEST will be on Thursday of this week.

English - We will continue with writing statements and questions this week. There will also be a Writing Journal assignment on Friday.

Handwriting - the letters we are printing this week are: Ii, Jj, Kk, and Ll.

Religion:

We will begin with Chapter 1 in our books entitled: Jesus is the Son of God. We will write all the new vocabulary words in our booklets. Our books will come home every Thursday night to be reviewed and completed with our parents. Before sending them back to school on Friday you will need to sign on the assigned page. This is important. If the book is not signed, it will come back home on Friday. We will attend Adoration as a class on Thursday.

Science/Health:

Continue Chapter 1 - Animals Change: mammals, human, reptiles and birds. The Chapter 1 TEST will be given on Tuesday, Sept. 8th. It is important to practice the blue Study Guide nightly at home.

Social Studies:

Continue with Unit 1 - We Belong to Many Groups. We will discuss: Our Country of Many People and ways we can help our world. The TEST over Chapter 1 will be on Tuesday, Sept. 15th. Practice the vocabulary words on the pink sheet with your child.

Math:

We will review for the Chapter TEST which will be on Wednesday, September 9th. Our next Chapter will be: Addition.
