Language Arts:

Reading - Our new story this week: Mr. Putter and Tabby..... Your child will bring his/her book home on Tuesday to read to you. Please remember to sign the colored note and return it on Wednesday. Skills: base words, plots, -ed and -ing endings, phonemic awareness, retelling and lists.

Spelling - List 153 Test will be on Friday. This list contains mainly of words with a Long E and O sounds. The list will come home on Friday so please start practicing over the weekend.

VoWac - TEST and Lesson 148 will be studied this week. We will learn about the Ways to Spell long A and review: -ch and -tch. We will review how to separate words into words parts according to vowel/consonant position within a word, the Sam Likes Fried Zebra rule and Fat Cat/Skinny Kitty rule.

English - We will begin to write commands and exclamations in our writing this week. We will also be writing a narrative description about someone close to us.

Handwriting - the letters we are printing this week are: Kk, and Ll, Mm, and Nn.

Religion:

WE will be reading Chapter 2 in our books entitled: Jesus Christ gives us the Church. Our new vocabulary words are: disciples, apostles, resurrection, and church. I am SO PLEASED with your children!
