## Language Arts:

**Reading** - Our new story this week: Fighting the Fire. Your child will bring his/her book home on Tuesday to read to you. Please remember to sign the colored note and return it on Wednesday. Skills: phonemic awareness, retelling, blending, main idea and details, parts of a book, and fluency.

**Spelling** - List 155 **TEST** will be on Friday. This list contains mainly of words with Long "I" sounds. The list will come home on Friday so please start practicing over the weekend.

**VoWac** - Lessons 149 - 151 will be studied this week. We will review the Ways to Spell long A, "ai and AY" vowel teams, and "ee and ea" vowel teams. We will be having a **TEST** over the green sheet - 4 Ways to Spell Long A on Wednesday.

**English** - Simple Subjects and Predicates and writing a friendly letter.

**Handwriting** - the letters we are printing this week are: Kk, and Ll, Mm, and Nn.

## Religion:

We will be reading Chapter 3 in our books entitled: We Celebrate God's Love. Our new vocabulary words are: catholic, parishes, faith, worship and sacrament.
