Language Arts:

Reading – our story this week is titled: Meet the Super Croc. We will work on the following skills in class: vocabulary, prefixes and suffixes, consonant digraphs, summarizing, comprehension, and phonemic awareness.

Spelling – List 187 test will be on Friday. (oi and oy words). The paragraph is just as important as the list of words, please keep that in mind when studying with your child. We will be taking a practice test every Monday over the words on the list. If your child receives 100% on this test, he/she will not take the word list portion of the test on Friday. The paragraph WILL be taken by everyone each Friday. I am hoping this entices some to study their words over the weekend and possibly not have to study them during the week.

VoWac – unit TEST con't will be taken on Monday. Lessons 183 – 185 study syllable division V/CV and VC/CV.

English – We will be working in our Journal on Monday. The remainder of the week will be learning about past tense verbs and proper mechanics of letter writing (uppercase letters, endmarks, indentions, commas, etc.)

Religion:

Chapter 7 – Ordinary Time. We will discuss Ordinary Time in the season of the Church and the rosary this week. Please remember that it is important to sign the book when it comes home on Thursday. We will attend Adoration in the chapel every Thursday at 2:30.

Science

Chapter 7 – Changes in the Air con't. Clouds, weather, rain, snow and air temperature. Remember to review the Study Guide.

Social Studies:

Begin Unit #4 – People Make History con't. The weekly themes are: we remember the past, reading a history map, and communities grow and change.

Math:

Continue with 2-digit addition, making predictions, exploring addition with/without regrouping, recording addition. Again, please take the time to write down a few problems nightly for your child to work out according to the math papers that come home corrected or as homework for each day.
