Language Arts:

Reading – Our story this week will be Click, Clack, Moo Cows that Type. Our skills lessons will include: vocabulary, triple consonants, comprehension, phonemic awareness, combining sentences, cause and effect, synonyms/thesaurus, possessives and calendars. Please take the time to listen to your child read their story and ask them to retell it to you before signing the colored note.

Spelling – List 193 test will be on Friday. (oo and u words). The paragraph is just as important as the list of words, please keep that in mind when studying with your child. We will have a Pretest on Monday over the list words only.

VoWac – oo words, alphabetizing, vowel teams, u, and u-e words.

English – combining sentences with the word “and”, linking verbs, endmarks and Journaling.

Handwriting – only for those with “messy” papers this week.

Religion:

We will begin our unit on First Communion this week with a chapter titled: Jesus gives Us the Eucharist. We will attend Adoration on Thursday. Remember to mark your calendars for First Communion on April 18th for both parishes.

Science:

Chapter 7 Review for the Test that will be held on Thursday, January 28th. We will begin Chapter 8 – Earth and Sun also.

Social Studies:

Skills lessons: using a map grid and American Portraits.. Study the pink colored Study Guide nightly. It really only takes a few short minutes each night to keep up. The test will be coming up soon.
