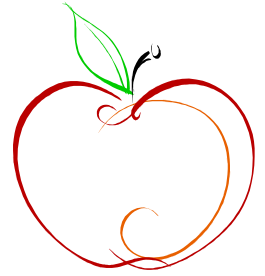


Sept. 8-11
