This is our second week with *Apples* as our theme in preschool. There are so many activities to do that can center on apples that I chose to have this theme again.

Early in the week, P2 and P3 will get to touch but not see various fruits. Can they identify these fruits without seeing them? This activity called “What is it?” will lead to a discussion on the characteristics of fruits.

P1 gets to finger paint big red apples. It may be messy (and lots of fun!) but we do have paint shirts!

Other activities include an apple counting activity on the new white board, religion lessons, reading 10 Apples Up on Top, learning that ‘A’ is for apple, and recognizing one’s own name. If your child easily recognizes his/her name then it’s time to practice printing it. Make sure only the first letter is upper case; the rest should be lower case.
