A few of the activities planned for this week include:

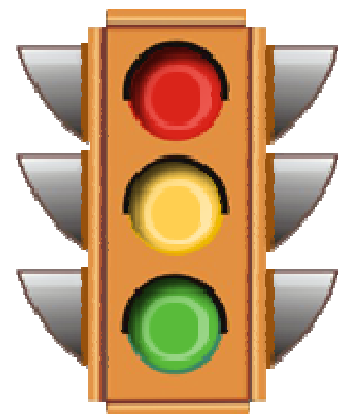
- * taking a safety walk to practice crossing streets and to search for safety signs
