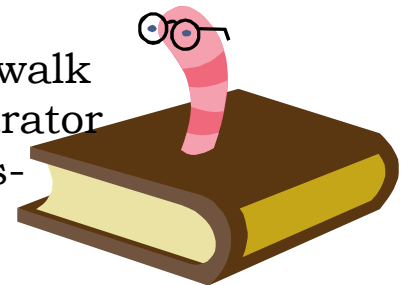
Dear Families,

The third week in November is *National Children's Book Week*. We will celebrate this theme with a collection of activities designed to capture the interest of your little bookworms. Buddy the Bookworm, a puppet, will be around to guide the class through the book activities.
