

News From 3R

September 7th-11th

Religion: We will start the first chapter in our book: God sends us his own son. Students will define vocabulary words and complete the review at the end of the chapter. Religion books will go home Wednesday for you and your child to go over the chapter together, and for you to sign. On Thursday, we will take part in Adoration. Mass will be on Friday from 9:00 to 10:00.

Spelling: Students will be tested over Lesson 4 on Friday. They will complete pages 18-21 in the Spelling book.

Reading: *Whose Habitat is it?* will be our next story we read. We will work on the strategies of summarizing, main idea, and details. Books will come home on Thursday for your child to read the story to you. Students will write down vocabulary words from the story that they will be tested over on Friday.

English: Unit 1 test will be on Tuesday. Students will take home their books to study over the weekend. Our next chapter will cover nouns.

Vowac: We will finish unit 24 with reviewing open, closed, and vowel consonant silent 'e' syllables. Unit 24 test will be on Thursday. Students should be studying the study guide sent home.

Math: We work on place value to one hundred thousand and work with money this week. Please work on the following skills with your child: addition facts (up to 4 digits), rounding numbers, place value, counting money, and counting by 2s, 3s, 4s, 5s, and 10s.

Social Studies: (Mrs. Rokusek) We will continue to learn about what a community is. This week lessons will focus on the fact that communities are people and how communities bring people together. Students will be reading, taking notes, and completing worksheets this week.

Science: (Mrs. Yahne) There will be a review on Wednesday with a test to follow on Thursday. All science sheets and vocabulary need to be studied on a daily basis. Most of the test will be over vocabulary so your child needs to study the vocabulary really hard.

Handwriting: We will review letters we have learned so far, and we will learn the cursive /r/.
