Religion: Chapter 2: Jesus Teaches Us About God's Love; Students will define vocabulary words for the chapter, which will be due on Thursday. Religion books will go home Thursday for your child to complete the chapter review, for you and your child to go over the chapter together, and for you to sign. On Thursday, we will take part in Adoration. Mass will be on Friday from 9:00 to 10:00.

Spelling: Students will be tested over Lesson 19 on Friday. They will complete pages 78-81 in the Spelling book.

Reading: This week we will read *Penguin Chick*. We will work on the strategies of summarizing, main idea, and details while reading the story. Books will come home on Wednesday for your child to read the story to you. Students will write down vocabulary words from the story that they will be tested over on Thursday.

English: Nouns will be our focus this week. We will learn what a noun is, common nouns, proper nouns, and nouns in the subject.

Vowac: Unit 25 will address vowel teams! This week we will learn the following long a vowel teams: ai, ay, eigh, ei.

Math: We will finish working with place value and money this week and take a test on Thursday. Please work on the following skills with your child: addition facts (up to 4 digits), rounding numbers, place value, counting money, comparing numbers, comparing money, and counting by 2s, 3s, 4s, 5s, and 10s.

Social Studies: (Mrs. Rokusek) Building citizenship, traditions, and meeting the needs in communities will be discussed this week. We will be planning to have a test over Chapter 1 on Thursday, September 24th. There is a study guide for your child to study from. This will be taken home on Thursday this week.

Science: (Mrs. Yahne) We will begin lesson 4 this week on the needs of animals. This will be a fun unit for the children to learn about animals. There will be another vocabulary sheet that your child will be working on for this next unit.

Handwriting: We will learn cursive s and p this week.
