September 21st-25th

Religion: 3R and 6H will be preparing the mass for this week. In the classroom, we will be practicing our parts. On Thursday, we will take part in Adoration. Mass will be on Friday from 9:00 to 10:00.

Spelling: Students will be tested over Lesson 20 on Friday. They will complete pages 82-85 in the Spelling book.

Reading: This week we will read *The Perfect Pet*. We will work on the strategy of finding the problem and solution in the story. Books will come home on Thursday for your child to read the story to you. Students will write down vocabulary words from the story that they will be tested over on Friday. **We will be going to Brady on Monday to read to the residents. Please make sure your child is wearing his or her uniform on that day. Thank you!!**

English: Nouns will be our focus this week. We will learn about singular nouns and plural nouns.

Vowac: Ways to spell the Long i and Long e will be our focus this week.

Math: We will start Chapter 2 this week. We will learn how to compare numbers and money, how to put them in order, how to estimate the quantities, and rounding. Please work on the following skills with your child: addition facts (up to 4 digits), rounding numbers, place value, counting money, comparing numbers, comparing money, and counting by 2s, 3s, 4s, 5s, and 10s.

Social Studies: (Mrs. Rokusek) We will finish discussing Chapter 1 and take a test over it on Thursday. Your child should be studying daily. It would be helpful for them to study their notes, pages 14-35 in the book, and the study guide.

Science: (Mrs. Yahne) We will begin lesson 5 this week on how animals grow. We will read and discuss this lesson and work on our vocabulary sheets. Please remind your child to bring their vocabulary sheet home on a regular basis.

Handwriting: We will learn cursive j and a this week.
