

News From 3R

January 4th-8th

Religion: We will be covering Chapter 10: The Church Prays. Religion books will come home on Wednesday for you and your child to go over the chapter together, and for your child to complete the chapter review. On Thursday, we will go to Adoration. On Friday, we will have mass from 9-10am.

Spelling: Students will be tested over Lesson 13 on Friday (They will get the list on Monday after the Pre-test). They will complete pages 54-47 in the Spelling book.

Reading: This week we will read *Seven Spools of Thread*. We will work on drawing conclusions while we read the story. Books will come home on Wednesday for your child to read the story to you. Students will write down vocabulary words from the story that they will be tested over on Thursday. We will finish the week by completing comprehension activities.

English: We will learn when to use to, two, and too. We will also work on synonyms and antonyms.

Vowac: Unit 27 will focus on R controlled syllables. This week we will discuss 'or' as in tractor and 'ar' as in dollar.

Math: We will continue to work on multiplication facts 0 to 9. I strongly encourage the students to work on the facts at home. Chapter 11 Test will be on Wednesday over multiplication facts 0 to 9. In the next chapter, we will learn how to multiply by 10 and 11. Please work on the following skills with your child: telling time, addition facts (up to 4 digits), rounding numbers, place value, counting money, comparing numbers, comparing money, and counting by 2s, 3s, 4s, 5s, and 10s.

Social Studies: (Mrs. Rokusek) This week we will be discussing the meaning and importance of the Declaration of Independence and Constitution.

Science: (Mrs. Yahne) The themes this week will be minerals and rocks, and kinds of soil. If your child has any rocks or minerals they would like to bring and share with the class, they sure can. This will be a fun unit.

Handwriting: This week we will learn /M/ and /K/.
