

News From 3R

January 11th-15th

Religion: 3R and 6H are responsible for the mass this week. In the classroom, we will be practicing our parts to prepare for the mass and finish chapter 10. On Thursday, we will go to Adoration. On Friday, we will have mass from 9-10am.

Spelling: Students will be tested over Lesson 13 on Monday. Students will be tested over Lesson 14 on Friday. There will not be a pretest for Lesson 14 this week. They will complete pages 58-61 in the Spelling book.

Reading: Students will take the Vocabulary Test over Seven Spools of Thread on Monday. This week we will read *Washington Weed Whackers*. We will work on comparing and contrasting while we read the story. Books will come home on Wednesday for your child to read the story to you. Students will write down vocabulary words from the story that they will be tested over on Thursday. We will finish the week by completing comprehension activities.

English: The Unit 7 Test will be on Thursday over adjectives and adverbs.

Vowac: Unit 27 will focus on R controlled syllables. This week we will discuss ar /er/ as in dollar, 'ear' /er/ as in earn, and 'ear' /ear/ as in fear.

Math: We will take the Chapter 11 Test on Monday. This week we will learn how to multiply by 10 and 11, and how to multiply 3 numbers. The Chapter 12 Test will be on Friday. Please work on the following skills with your child: telling time, addition facts (up to 4 digits), rounding numbers, place value, counting money, comparing numbers, comparing money, and counting by 2s, 3s, 4s, 5s, and 10s.

Social Studies: (Mrs. Rokusek) We will continue to discuss the meaning and importance of the Declaration of Independence and Constitution.

Science: (Mrs. Yahne) This week we will be talking about fossils and fuel, and water, sea and land. The test that will be coming up will be over vocabulary, so be sure to save the vocabulary.

Handwriting: This week we will learn /H/ and /U/.
