

# News From 3R

January 18<sup>th</sup>-22<sup>nd</sup>

**Religion:** We will be covering Chapter 11: The Parish is our Home. Religion books will come home on Wednesday for you and your child to go over the chapter together, and for your child to complete the chapter review. On Thursday, we will go to Adoration. On Friday, we will have mass from 9-10am.

**Spelling:** Students will be tested over Lesson 17 on Friday. They will complete pages 70-73 in the Spelling book.

**Reading:** This week we will read *Here's My Dollar*. We will work on the author's purpose while we read the story. Books will come home on Wednesday for your child to read the story to you. Students will write down vocabulary words from the story that they will be tested over on Thursday. We will finish the week by completing activities that will help us with contrasting, characters, inference, main idea, and cause and effect.

**English:** We will start a new unit this week over capitalization and punctuation. This week we will work on correct sentences and capitalizing proper nouns.

**Vowac:** Unit 27 will focus on R controlled syllables. This week we will discuss ear /air/ as in bear and air /air/ as in chair. A study guide will be sent home this week for your child to begin studying for the test on January 26<sup>th</sup>.

**Math:** DIVISION!!! This week we will explore what division is and relate it to subtraction and multiplication. If your child has been working on their multiplication facts everyday, division facts will come to them quickly. Please work on the following skills with your child: telling time, addition facts (up to 4 digits), rounding numbers, place value, counting money, comparing numbers, comparing money, and counting by 2s, 3s, 4s, 5s, and 10s.

**Social Studies:** (Mrs. Rokusek) This week we will be discussing the meaning and importance of the Declaration of Independence and Constitution.

**Science:** (Mrs. Yahne) Lesson 3: Fossils and Fuel and Lesson 4: Water in sea, land and sky

**Handwriting:** This week we will learn /Y/ and /Z/.
