Religion: We will be covering Chapter 12: God Calls Each of Us. Religion books will come home on Thursday for you and your child to go over the chapter together, and for your child to complete the chapter review. On Monday, I will be testing the students on their prayers. This will include the Apostles' Creed. On Friday, we will have mass from 9-10am.

Spelling: Students will be tested over Lesson 23 on Friday. They will complete pages 94-97 in the Spelling book.

Reading: This week we will read *My Very Own Room*. We will work on predicting while we read the story. Books will come home on Thursday for your child to read the story to you. Students will write down vocabulary words from the story that they will be tested over on Friday.
On Monday, we will be going over to Brady to read from 10:30 to 11:00. Please make sure your child wears his or her uniform on that day. Thank you!

English: Capitalizing proper nouns, learning abbreviations, and writing book titles will be our focus this week.

Vowac: Unit 27 Test will be on Tuesday. We will then move onto learning consonant –le syllables.

Math: Chapter 13 Test will be on Tuesday. The rest of the week we will be learning different division facts. If your child has been working on their multiplication facts everyday, division facts will come to them quickly.
Please work on the following skills with your child: division facts, multiplication facts, telling time, addition facts (up to 4 digits), rounding numbers, place value, counting money, comparing numbers, comparing money, and counting by 2s, 3s, 4s, 5s, and 10s.

Social Studies: (Mrs. Rokusek) This week we will finish our discussion over the meaning and importance of the Constitution.

Science: (Mrs. Yahne) This week we will continue on Chapter 5 Water in Sea, Land and Sky also Saving our Resources. We will be having a test coming on which will focus on vocabulary. Be sure to study the vocabulary on a daily basis. There will be no study guide this time.

Handwriting: This week we will learn /V/ and /X/.
