

# News From 3R

**Religion:** We will be covering Chapter 15: We Celebrate the Sacraments. Religion books will come home on Wednesday for you and your child to go over the chapter together, and for your child to complete the chapter review. On Thursday, we will take part in Adoration. On Friday, we will have mass from 9-10am. Due to the snow day, I was not able to test students on their prayers. I will be testing students the week of Feb. 8<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup>.

**Spelling:** Students will be tested over Lesson 18 on Friday. They will complete pages 74-77 in the Spelling book.

**Reading:** This week we will read *Boom Town*. We will work on putting story details in sequence while we read the story. Books will come home on Wednesday for your child to read the story to you. Students will write down vocabulary words from the story that they will be tested over on Thursday.

**English:** How to use commas will be our focus this week.

**Vowac:** Unit 28 will focus on the consonant -le syllables.

**Math:** Chapter 14-15 test will be on Thursday over division facts 0-11. Please encourage your child to practice his or her flashcards daily.

Please work on the following skills with your child: division facts, multiplication facts, telling time, addition facts (up to 4 digits), rounding numbers, place value, counting money, comparing numbers, comparing money, and counting by 2s, 3s, 4s, 5s, and 10s.

**Social Studies:** (Mrs. Rokusek) February is Black History Month. In Social Studies, we will be researching an African American person and creating a poster about them.

**Science:** (Mrs. Yahne) This week we will be doing the review at the end of the chapter plus looking at rocks on the promethean board.

**Handwriting:** This week we will learn /W/ and /T/.
