Religion: Chapter 2: Jesus teaches us about God's Love We will continue to do the vocabulary for this chapter. Again, the book will come home on Tuesday which needs to have the review completed and your signature is required. Math: Chapter 2 themes include: Order numbers, estimating quantities, rounding to the tens, hundreds and thousands. Be sure to practice these past lessons on place value, properties of addition and money.

Reading: The story this week is called "Penguin Chick" The skills we will be working on include dictionary, main idea, details, character, plot, setting, homographs and summarizing.

Vowac: Lessons 232 and 233 which include these vowel teams: ai, ay, eigh and ei. Any worksheets that come home may be practiced on a daily basis.

Spelling: Chapter 19: Words with "air" and "are". Continue to study over the weekend for the pretest.

English: Chapter 3 will be the study of nouns. The focus for the week include: what are nouns, common/proper nouns, nouns in the subject, and a singular/plural noun.

Science (Mrs. Yahne): We will begin lesson 4 this week on the needs of animals. This will be a fun unit for the children to learn about animals. There will be another vocabulary sheet that your child will be working on for this next unit.

Social Studies (Mrs. Rokusek). Building citizenship, traditions, and meeting the needs in communities will be discussed this week. We will be planning to have a test over Chapter 1 on Thursday, September 24th. There is a study guide for your child to study from. This will be taken home on Thursday this week.
